Dr. Amal Mattu has had a passion for teaching and writing about emergency cardiology since he joined the faculty at the University of Maryland School of Medicine in 1996.

He has authored or edited more than 30 textbooks in emergency medicine, including 11 focused on emergency cardiology and electrocardiography.

He is the only emergency physician to be invited to serve as primary Guest Editor for Cardiology Clinics three times.

He has lectured in 31 countries spanning six continents on emergency cardiology topics, and he has helped to create and direct multiple conferences, podcasts, and videocasts focused on this area. 
